Contaminated water, poor health

- The Musahar (Rat Eating) Community
- Medicine ineffective
- Hand Pumps tested, contaminated water
- Govt. interventions are individual/group handpumps and large village schemes
- Community discusses other options for safe drinking water

Developing a low-cost, effective solution

Community contributes 10% of capital cost & monthly water charges

AKRSP(I) establishes a low-cost water testing laboratory accessible to the community

Panchayats and women self-help groups involved at all stages

AKRSP(I) then withdraws after 2 years.




